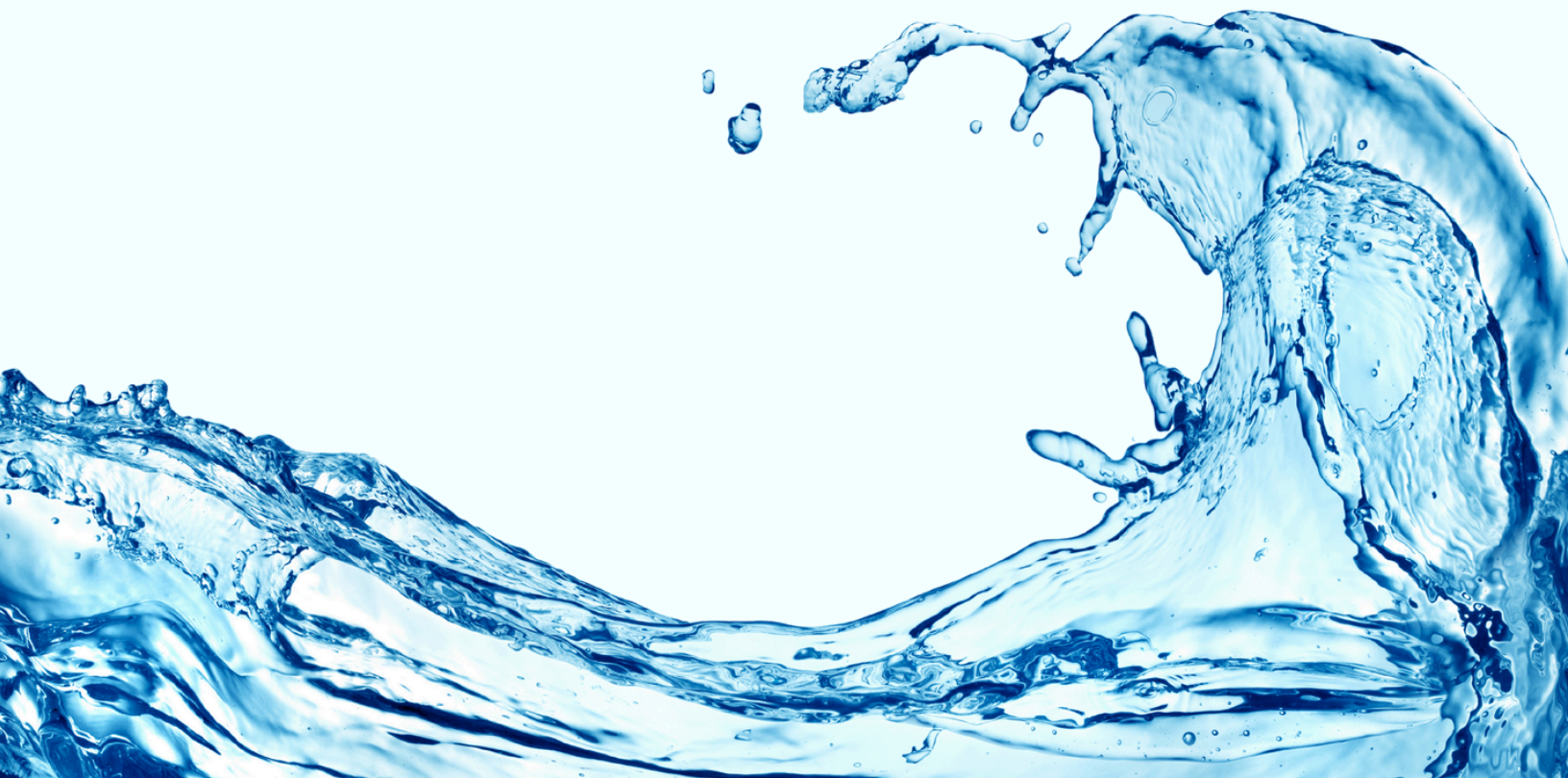
Presidents Message

Legislative News

Hello all!

The Senate will reconvene on Monday March 16, 2026 at 1:00PM, and The House will reconvene on Monday March 23, 2026, at 12:00PM Voting Session
Pennsylvania Senate Bill 395 titled the Plumber and Plumbing Contractors Licensure Act

This month's article is on Pennsylvania Senate Bill 395, introduced in March 2025. This Bill is one to keep an eye on as it proposes establishing a statewide plumbing licensure system for apprentice plumbers, journeyman plumbers, and master plumbers.

At the heart of the bill is the creation of a State Board of Plumbing Contractors, responsible for licensing, exams, renewals, continuing education, and maintaining a public registry. The bill lays out clear requirements for each licensure level, including experience, education, insurance, and exams.

Notably, it includes an 18-month window for experienced practitioners to obtain licensure without examination. Importantly for Philadelphia, SB 395 would not prevent municipalities from enforcing their own plumbing codes or inspection processes. Instead, it ensures that a state license would serve as proof of competence, while still allowing cities to manage permitting, business licenses.

If enacted, most provisions would take effect 18 months later, giving the Board time to form and begin rulemaking. For plumbing engineers involved in design, plan review, and coordination with contractors, greater uniformity can ultimately streamline project delivery and reduce interpretation issues across jurisdictions.

So, the bill has been proposed in the Senate, and the last action was being referred to the Consumer Protection & Professional Licensure. This Legislation is currently in the Senate, and we shall see where it goes from there.
